

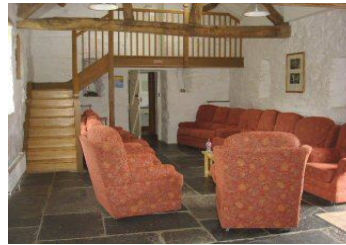

# Conservation Holiday with the National Trust

**Friday 19<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2010**

A weekend working holiday at an inclusive cost of £35 has been arranged for the weekend of 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> March 2010 on the National Trust Ysbyty Estate, Betws-y-Coed, North Wales. We arrive late Friday afternoon and after an evening meal the evening is free. On Saturday we will undertake conservation work on the National Trust Ysbyty Estate under the supervision of a National Trust Warden. The Ysbyty Estate is the largest estate cared for by The National Trust covering 8000 hectares. It encompasses moorland, river valleys and 51 hill farms. Sunday will be a day of leisure for those attending. We will vacate the accommodation late Sunday afternoon.



As the weekend will entail conservation work you should ensure that you are fit enough to undertake such work, the work will not be strenuous but will be demanding and we may be working in poor weather conditions. The accommodation is of a good standard with central heating and dormitory accommodation (Similar to YHA) with self-catering meals provided.
